**Notable Observations and Suggestions:**

1. Few Departments obtained awards in academic / co-curricular / extra-curricular activities like Biotechnology. In addition, Departmental Activities like Arthanomics and others are good.
2. Encouragement for students and participation in EXPLORE, E-Shodh, AVISHKAR is good.
3. Bridge Course in Math is for Chemists taken by Department of Chemistry, MCS - Big Data Analytics is good. Such courses can be introduced for others.
4. Entrepreneurship Cell, Start - Ups, Networking and Ventures are noteworthy.
5. Many Departments have Departmental Magazine and E-Journals having ISSN Number.
6. Good to see B. Voc. Courses like Travel and Tourism Management, Software Development.
7. 'Golden Hour' Concept is unique practice.
8. Certificate Courses conducted by few departments like Life Skills by Psychology, Clinical Research by Microbiology and Certificate Course in Forensic Science by Life Science Department deserve appreciation.
9. College is performing as team under able leadership and guidance of IQAC.
10. All the staff members including administrative staff deserves appreciation for their commitment, well informed positive responses.
11. College has adequate infrastructure and young minds to shoulder future responsibilities.
12. Suggestions made by the experts to all the departments need to be implemented in phased manner by Plan of Action (POA).
13. IQAC may constitute a separate working group for implementation of NEP, Inter departmental / faculty credit courses.
14. College with all faculty may organise some minimum common social outreach activities.
15. College yet to explore its potential of consultancy, research and resource mobilization.
16. Departments having E- Journal / Magazine / Book writing skills should be given incentives, non-monetary recognitions or appreciations.
17. College has received awards in research competitions at state level. This needs to be more strengthened by formation of Advance Research Centre through exploring possibilities of collaboration with reputed research institutions.
18. College has few international collaborations and MoU, there is a scope for exposure to have joint academic programmes abroad for teachers and students both.

19. Teachers have research and publications, but college should make more efforts to attract financial assistance for Minor / Major research projects from UGC, ICSSR, DST, CENTRAL / STATE GOVT. FUNDING agencies.
20. College should introduce Internal Academic Monitoring Committee for T / L activities, attendance, remedial coaching, coursera courses, content development, community outreach activities, competitive exams, bridge course, internship, counselling etc. under the guidance of IQAC.
21. To cultivate habit amongst students / teachers for research tailor made courses such as SAP, SPSS, DATA ANALYST, QUANTITATIVE TECHNIQUES to be introduced.
22. On job training, entrepreneurship startup companies, to be encouraged.
23. Demand for future employers are kept in mind while framing and revising the curriculum.
24. College should think of Faculty motivation policy. Consultancy policy, Budget policy for department and club activities.
25. Management should have complete Automisation and Digitalization of office administration.

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
