Based on the theme of 'Olympus', Taliassh202223 brought back the world of Greek gods and heroes. It had various event categories like management events including Finastics, Eurika,




and Bazinga, informal events like Bull's Eye and Connection Contention, and sports events like Capture the Flag and SuperBall.
