Credit Structure under NEP - 2020

Under the New Education Policy (NEP - 2020), students will have to earn a total of 22 credits per semester which will include the Major Subject opted for, and a Minor Subject from the same stream. Apart from this there will be Vocational Skill Courses and Skill Enhancement Courses related to the Major Subject, Ability Enhancement Course (English) and Modern Indian Language Course related to Communication Skills, Indian Knowledge System Course and Open (Generic) Elective Courses from other streams. The student can earn the Graduate Degree with 132 Credits after 3 years or an Honours Graduate Degree with 176 Credits after 4 years.
