We the undersigned, Jai Hind College and Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (hereinafter called "APU") seeking to contribute to the development of human resources and to the achievement of sustainable growth and peaceful coexistence in the Asia-Pacific region, today complete this Agreement for the Recommendation of Students for admission to APU.

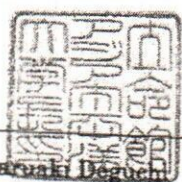
1. Jai Hind College will recommend suitable non-Japanese national candidates for admission to APU annually.
2. APU will inform Jai Hind College of the admission requirements as written in the Undergraduate Application Handbook, the Agreement Outline, and the "Implementation Outline for the Recommendation of Students" each academic year prior to the date from which recommendations will be accepted.
3. APU shall give preference to the students that Jai Hind College recommends pursuant to this Agreement, but will in all instances make the final determination of whether or not to grant admission.
4. This Agreement shall be valid from the date of signing by both parties until April 30, 2023. Following this period, by the end of April 2023, the Agreement will be reviewed and renewed upon consultation between both the signing parties.
5. The parties may modify these terms upon mutual agreement.
6. This agreement is to be concluded in English with each party receiving one original. Both copies are of equal validity.

Agreement Outline for Recommendation of Students to

Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University

This Agreement Outline sets the guidelines for the "Agreement for Recommendation of Students to Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University" concluded between Jai Hind College and Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (hereinafter "APU").

1. Programs for Recommendation

College of Asia Pacific Studies
College of International Management

2. Admissions for Japanese/Domestic Applicants and International Applicants

At the time of application, the recommended applicants who possess Japanese nationality or permanent residency should apply for "Admissions for Japanese/Domestic Applicants", and the applicants who have any nationality other than Japanese should apply for "Admissions for International Applicants Residing Outside Japan." Students recommended in accordance to this Agreement must be applying for "Admissions for International Applicants Residing Outside Japan."

3. Recommendation dates

Applicants shall be recommended to APU by the following dates:

- For April enrollment: by the deadline of the application period for that year's April enrollment.
- For September enrollment: by the deadline of the application period for that year's September enrollment.

4. Recommendation process

The following documents shall be submitted to APU directly by the recommended applicant:

1. The required documents as specified in the Undergraduate Application Handbook issued by APU.
2. An official Letter of Recommendation signed by the Principal of Jai Hind College

5. Recommendation Criteria

Applicants must satisfy all requirements for first year applications outlined in the Undergraduate Application Handbook for International Applicants Residing Outside Japan.

6 Tuition Reduction Scholarships

The recommended applicant can receive at minimum a 65% Tuition Reduction Scholarship in regards to the Regulation of APU Tuition Reduction Scholarships. However, based on the evaluation of the applicant's documents and interview performance, a Tuition Reduction Scholarship higher than 65% can be awarded. Details regarding the Tuition Reduction Scholarships are listed below.

The Regulation of APU Tuition Reduction Scholarships

1. The APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship system was established for the purpose of reducing the financial burden of partial or full tuition for international students to allow continuation of their studies at APU.
2. Applicants who are eligible to apply for the APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship must have obtained or be scheduled to obtain a student visa by the time of enrollment and must be a privately financed international students.
3. APU Tuition Reduction Scholarships are offered in the following percentages.
 - i. 100% Tuition Reduction
 - ii. 80% Tuition Reduction
 - iii. 65% Tuition Reduction
4. Scholarship funds shall be provided on a semester basis and will continue to be awarded through the applicant's period of study through the minimum number of years required to graduate.
5. Recipients will stop receiving this scholarship immediately under any of the following circumstances.
 - i. Leave of Absence from APU
 - ii. Other behavior judged by APU to be unbecoming of a scholarship recipient
6. Recipients will lose their eligibility to receive this scholarship starting in the next semester under any of the following circumstances.
 - i. Loss of Student status or withdrawal from APU
 - ii. Receipt of two consecutive warnings as a result of failing to meet the minimum GPA requirement from the first to sixth semester.
 - iii. Receipt of the warning as a result of failing to meet the minimum GPA requirement after the seventh semester.
 - iv. Discovery of any false information or forgeries on submitted documents.
 - v. Other behavior judged by APU to be unbecoming of a scholarship recipient

Implementation Outline for the Recommendation of Students to Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University

Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University seeks the recommendation of students who have the appropriate academic ability and who have a strong willingness to actively contribute to student life upon enrollment.

1. Recommendation Schema

Courses for Recommendation	Applicant Quota	Tuition Reduction Percentage
Asia Pacific Studies (APS) International Management (APM)	1	65%*2

*1One student per year can be recommended.

*2Based on the evaluation of the applicant's documents and interview performance, a Tuition Reduction Scholarship higher than 65% can be awarded.

2. Recommendation Criteria

Applicants must satisfy all of the application requirements specified in the "Undergraduate Application Handbook for International Applicants Residing Outside Japan" and the following criterion for (1), (2), (3), and (4).

(1) Language Ability

TOEFL: A score of iBT 92 and above

IELTS: A score of 7.0 and above (a minimum of 5.5 is required for each section)

(2) CBSE Class XII Results: 82% and above

(2) Grade Percentage: 83% and above (for 2 or 3 years)

IB Diploma (including predicted scores) : 33 and above

GCE Advanced Levels: A in at least three subjects or equivalent

(4) An official letter of recommendation signed by the President

3. Application Schedule

Applicants are required to apply online through the online application system, and submit the application form and all other supplementary documents as specified in the Undergraduate Application Handbook during the application period.

4. Application Fee

As shown in the Undergraduate Application Handbook.

5. Evaluation Method

Application results are based on a comprehensive evaluation of the submitted application forms, supplementary documents, and applicant's interview performance. As stated in the "Agreement for Recommendation of Students to Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University," even if the applicant fulfills all application criteria, the applicant's interview performance may impact the final determination of whether to grant admission.

6. Result Notification

Final results will be notified to the applicant and the school.

7. Required Application Documents

In addition to the required documents specified in the Undergraduate Application Handbook, applicants must submit an electronic version of the official letter of recommendation signed by the school's president in the online application.

8. Application Precautions

Students recommended in accordance with the "Agreement for Recommendation of Students to Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University" who are accepted will not be allowed to reapply in the same enrollment period.
