#### 1.7 GENERAL COORDINATORS



However, there shall be no liability on TCIL to engage any student as an Intern or employee and the decision of TCIL shall be final and binding in this regard.

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. This MoU is to impart a live and real feel of the business environment of the Company for students to enable them understand and also blend business with academics and has no guarantees or promise of future employment in the Company. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

## 2.0 COMMENCEMENT, RENEWAL, TERMINATION

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in force for a time period of one year, with a possibility for renewal at the end of the one year-period,

subject to the Parties' written agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving one (01) months' notice in writing to the other Party.

### 3.0 Jurisdiction

Any disputes or claims arising out of, or in connection with this MoU, its subject matter shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of Mumbai have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this MoU.


