Posters and sign boards with help line numbers and email id for lodging complaint are placed at strategic points in college. Drop boxes for students to complain about ragging is also placed in college premises. Every possible measures are taken to make students aware with repercussions of ragging and act as deterrent towards it. Seminars, poster competitions and street plays are conducted to spread awareness. With strong vigil in place the campus of Jai Hind can proudly say that it is ragging free.
