The **History Association** of JHC is a confluence of curious minds and dynamic ideas, fostering academic knowledge and real-life skills through various activities conducted by faculty and students.

Research Methodology Workshop (2018-2019): Prof. (Dr.) Preeta Nilesh guided students on research paper writing techniques, assisting in the preparation for the Annual Student Seminar.

Field Visits: SYBA students, accompanied by Dr. Archana, visited the CSMVS museum on 8th August 2018. They participated in interactive sessions focusing on the Indus Valley Civilization, Ashokan inscriptions, early Indian art, and conservation techniques, including discussions with craftsmen and conservators.

Community Outreach: SYBA Foundation Course students, led by Dr. Archana Mishra, visited Ashadaan NGO and undertook internships with various NGOs such as Dignity Foundation, Akansha, and Vatsalya Trust, as part of their community outreach projects.

Gender Sensitisation Workshop: On February 18th, 2019, the film "Boys Who Like Girls" was screened, followed by a session on gender issues and consent by MAVA and TISS. Students created documentaries on relationships and consent, with some participating in MAVA's gender sensitization events.
