Examination in Lieu of Mercy Chance

Examination Guidelines

Definition of Mercy Chance:

The college defines "Grant of Mercy Chance" as under:

"Maximum time limit required for completing the Bachelors/Masters program/course in order to be allowed to appear in the final year examination"

It is clarified that *"Mercy chance is not applicable to candidates who discontinue or re-join the program/course"* It is for this reason that *Grant of Mercy Chance is applicable only for FINAL YEAR Students.*


Eligibility: Mercy Chance will only be applicable to those candidates who have completed the Bachelors/Masters program/course (theory and practical) in the prescribed maximum time limit (double the duration of the program/course) and the candidate who was not able to clear the final year examinations of the respective program/course within the prescribed maximum duration.

Duration of the exams: 3 hours

Total Marks: 100

Maximum Number of attempts: 2

Examination Fee: The Examination fee will be decided on a case-by-case basis in line with the decision of the Controller of Examinations and in consultation with the Principal of the Institute.
